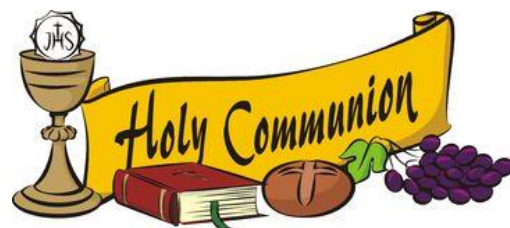
First Holy Communion

Jason (St Therese) ~ What a superstar this week! Jason has worked hard, been independent and brilliantly behaved on our trip. Great job, Jason!

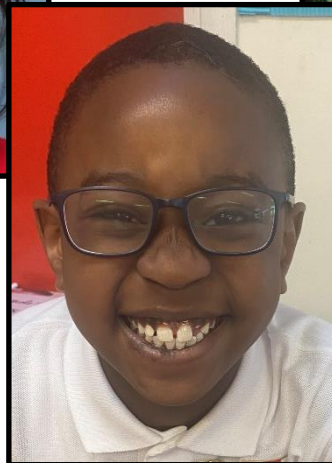
Jazmin (St Elizabeth) ~ for being a good friend to everyone and for trying hard in all areas of the curriculum.
