Harry & Robyn (St Peter) received their certificates for being **SUPER READERS**, reaching **250 reads**.

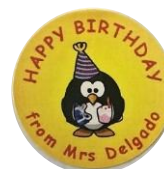
Next week will be our final week for reading certificates and we will be awarding our **OUTSTANDING READERS** with their certificate for **300 reads**.
