Please find below a selection of optional homework activities.

English Activities:-

- Make an acrostic poem about dinosaurs.
- Write sentences with the Common Exception words in them.
- Write different sentences that need either a full stop, exclamation mark or a question mark at the end.
- Apostrophes- write sentences that include words with the possessive apostrophe. E.g Sarah's coat was on the floor.
- Write interesting sentences with adjectives to describe a setting for a story.
- Subordination conjunctions - Use 'when', 'because' and 'if' in sentences to join clauses together.
- Homophones - Write sentences with homophones in them (Words that sound the same with different meanings) E.g I can see the sea.
- List five qualities about a character from your favourite fairy story.
- Write a book review.
- Write a fact file about Castle Life. Use sub headings for each paragraph. E.g Different types of castles, food eaten during the medieval period, clothes worn, interesting facts about knights etc.
- Write a story about a character that might live in a castle. E.g A princess, knight, giant.

- Play the online game 'Hit the Button' and select the number bonds, addition and subtraction games. (Search Hit The Button on your web browser).
- Log on to www.topmarks.co.uk and select 'Telling the Time'. Play the Mathsframe game by selecting different time challenges.
- Learn to tell the time using a digital clock.
- Weight - Find a variety of food items and place them in order from lightest to heaviest. Then record their weight in grams or kilograms.
- Capacity- Find a variety of different bottles/jars of liquid e.g a sauce bottle. Place the items in order from smallest to largest. Record their capacity in millilitres or litres.
