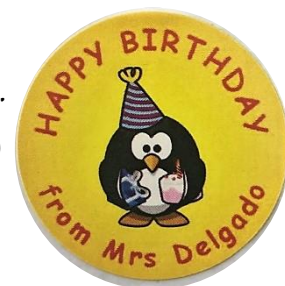

\*\* You can buy a red and white checked summer dress from the school or any stockist, Asda, Tesco etc. In order that it is accepted as school uniform, it must;

- ✓ be a red and white checked dress ~ no stripes
- ✓ have a predominately white collar (different edging designs are acceptable)

These can be ordered and paid for via WisePay and will come home with your child.
