Ellie (St Therese) ~ for being a super star in English. Ellie has tried to listen so hard to listen and apply all she is learning in her writing. You should feel very proud!

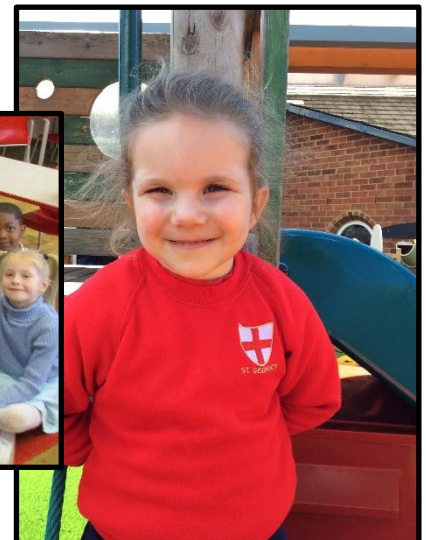
St Elizabeth's class ~ for working incredibly hard and trying their very best in our SATs this week. Mrs Gillett is very proud of each and every one of you!

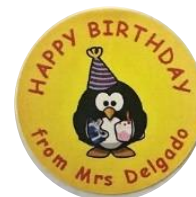
