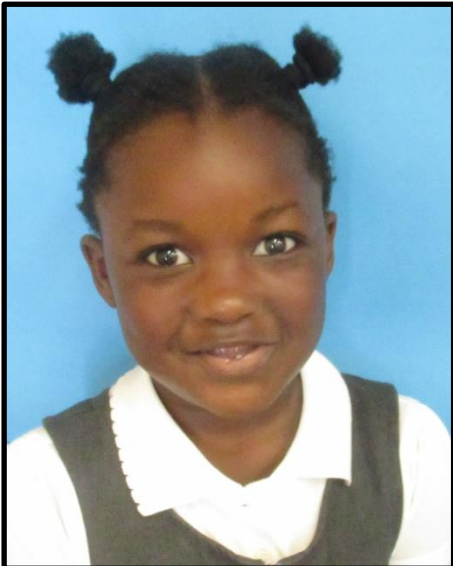
*Ruva (St Elizabeth) ~ for always working hard and for having the best smile in the world!*

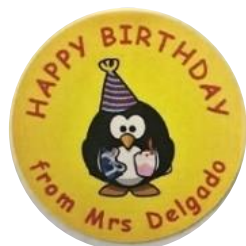
