Please find below a selection of optional homework activities.

English Activities:-

- **Compound words**- How many words can you think of that are made up of two words joined together. E.g. door+step=doorstep.
- **Suffixes** - think of five words that use each of the following suffixes. ful, ness, less and ment. E.g. ful - beautiful.
- **Contractions** - think of ten words made from joining two words together with the use of an apostrophe. E.g. had + not=hadn't
- **Prefixes**- Write five words that contain the prefixes - un and dis.
- Write a fact file about an animal that hibernates in the Autumn. Use sub headings for each paragraph. E.g. appearance, habitat, food, interesting facts.
- Learn to read and spell the Year 2 Common Exception Words.
- Find five words containing each of these phonemes - ea, ee, oa, ow, ew and oo.
- Make a poem about fireworks.
- Write a story about your favourite woodland animal.
- List five qualities about a character from your favourite fairy story.
- Read everyday.

Maths Activities:-

- Times Table Rock Stars.
- Play Hit the Button - addition and subtraction.
- Log on to www.topmarks.co.uk and select 'Telling the Time'. Play the Mathsframe game by selecting different time challenges.
- Make your own clock and have a go at telling the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. Once you are confident with that try to read the time to the nearest 5 minutes. Watch the video on time to help you.

- **Capacity**- Find a variety of different bottles/jars of liquid e.g a sauce bottle. Place the items in order from smallest to largest. Record the capacity in millilitres or litres.
- **Weight** - Find a variety of food items and place them in order from lightest to heaviest. Then record their weight in grams or kilograms.

- Read about God's Creation of the World and draw some pictures about it.
