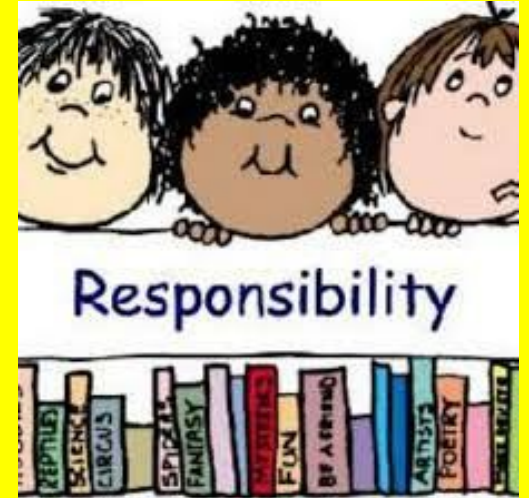

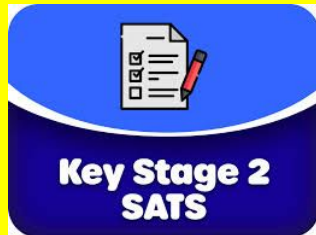
What's different about Year 6?

- Reinforcing expectations and values that we have at St. George's.



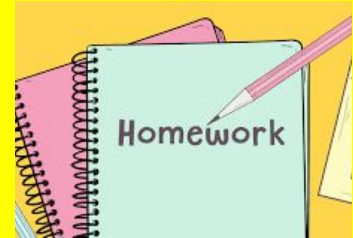
Key Points:

- **Punctuality** - Working for punctuality points - Being late impacts on early morning learning.
- **Attendance** - We want to see you - however, remember it's 48 hours off for sickness and diarrhoea.
- **School Uniform** - Uniform changes are indicated on newsletters, emails and on the school website. Please label all uniform.
- **Communicating** - Please communicate through the office where all information is passed on, I will get back to you as soon as I can.



Key Points:

- **Water bottles** - please have a named bottle in school each day. Sur hat or coat.
- **Healthy school policy** - we encourage healthy options for break and lunch.
- **Homework** - will be set every **Friday** and due in the following Friday. Homework will be Maths and English based (foundation subject homework occasionally set). We will go through the homework every Friday to check understanding.



Reward system for completion of homework and for handing it in on time.

A spelling rule will be introduced on **Tuesdays** - please review these weekly.

Reading

- Children can read with an adult and independently.
- Please write in your child's red reading record. Your child can write in their own reading record, however, please sign it at the bottom of each page to confirm that they have read.
- Children will be able to change their books as and when they have read them.
- Reading recorded from the 8th September will be recognised towards reading milestones.

- All hair must be tied up.



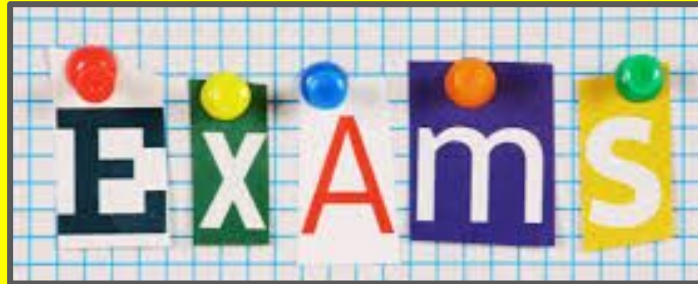
Behaviour

- **Monday, May 11th, 2026:** English grammar, punctuation, and spelling papers
- **Tuesday, May 12th, 2026:** English reading test
- **Wednesday, May 13th, 2026:** Mathematics papers (arithmetic and reasoning)
- **Thursday, May 14th, 2026:** Mathematics reasoning paper
