Iris-Ivy ~ (St Elizabeth) ~ for being a kind and caring friend to everyone and always trying her very best in all areas of the curriculum.

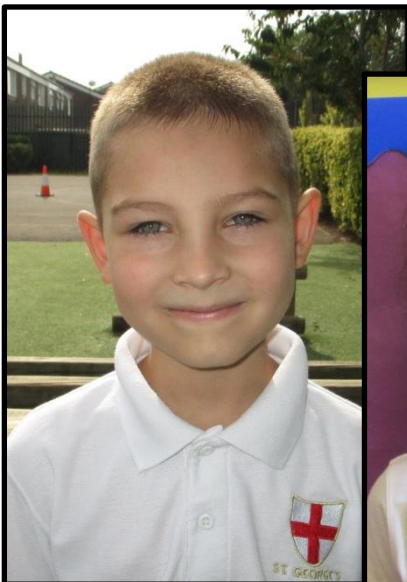
