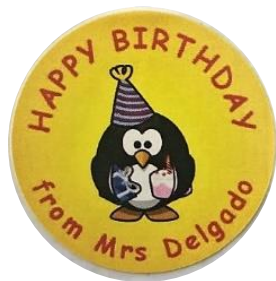

*Teddy (St Therese) ~ for being Teddy! He always gives his best and is always on task. Keep it up, Teddy!*

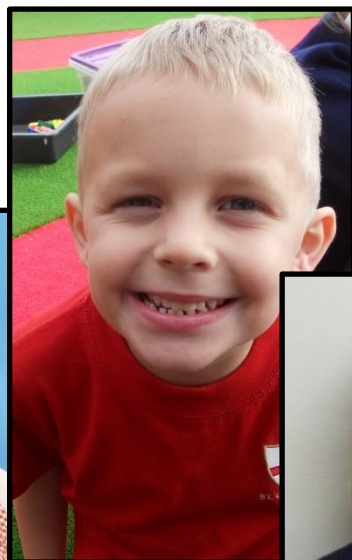
