Parking

A serious and ongoing concern has been raised by a local resident living near the school. They have addressed the repeated dangerous and inconsiderate parking behaviour of many parents during school drop-off and pick-up times.

Each day, they witness numerous vehicles illegally parked on double yellow lines and across pavements, particularly on Jackdaw Close and Anson Chase. These actions frequently narrow the roads to a single lane, cause considerable congestion, and significantly increase the risk to pedestrians—especially children. They have images of cars that are illegally parked (including number plate) and we will be sending these to Southend council's 'Report a parking problem', via the portal.

We always promote parents parking at Asda, or Shoebury Park car park and walking the last bit. Not only does it help with the problem of parking, but the children can also enjoy the walk - perhaps even meeting up with a friend, for a chat on the way in!

All of us have a responsibility to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all members of the community. Thank you in advance for your support.

a lovely time and came away thinking of all the ways we could help the centre.

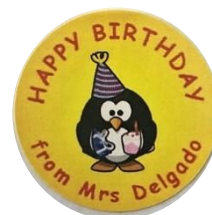
