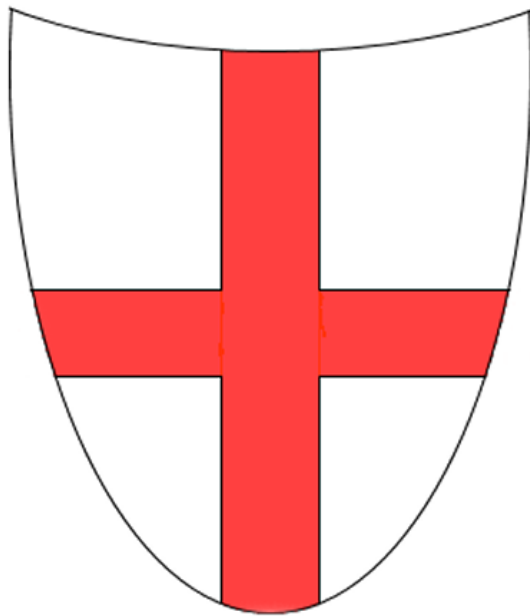

Tapestry - the online learning journal



Tapestry is an online learning journal which your child can treasure forever containing photos, writing and videos! The best part is you can access it 24 hours a day and even add to it at home! It is a secure password protected login in line with current data protection acts.

For Tapestry access we do need you to complete the permission forms. Permission allows your child's photos/ videos to be seen by the cohort - these are put on disk for you at the end of the year along with a memory book.

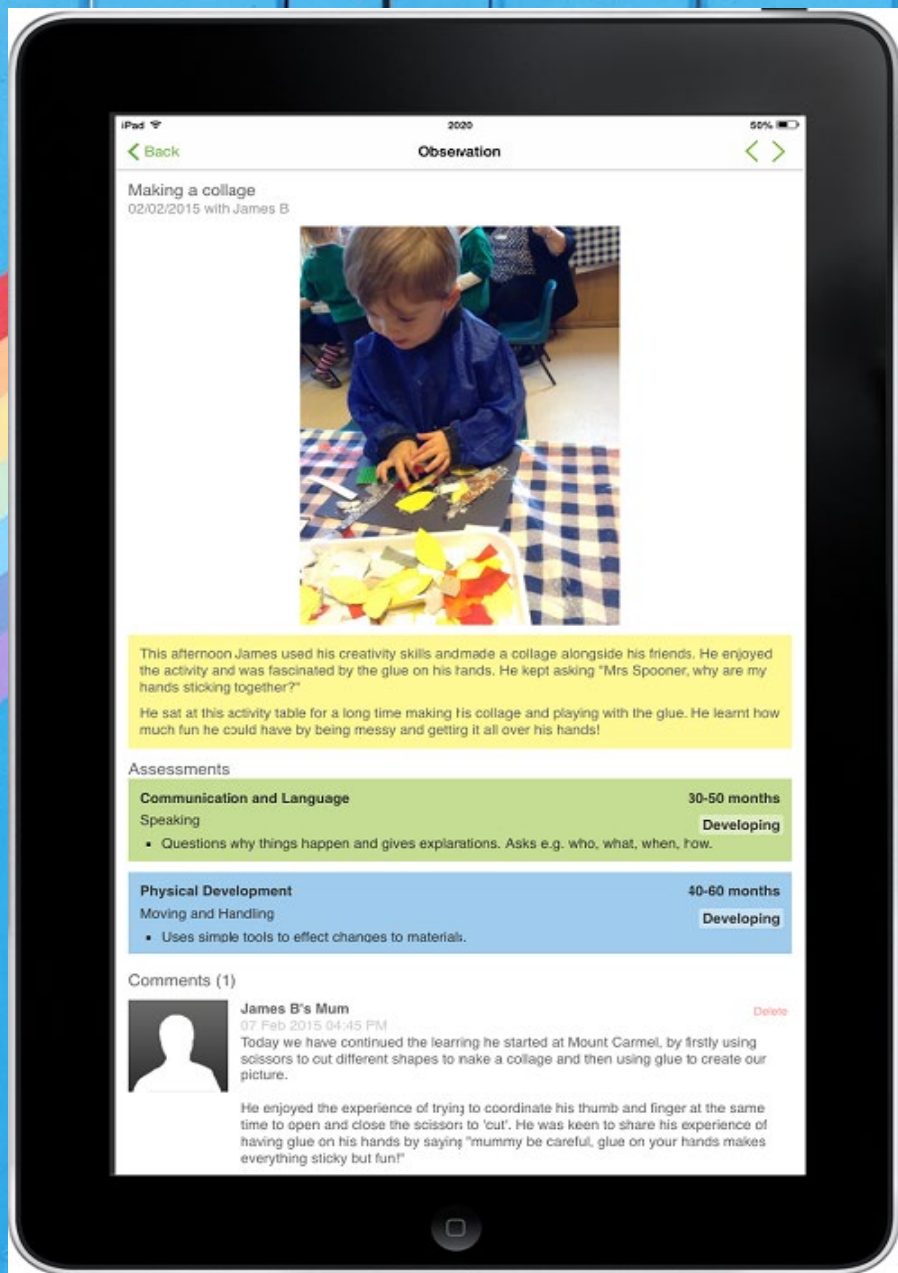

- Black shoes
- School jumper or cardigan*
- School tie* (elasticated or clip-on in Reception, Yr 1 & 2, clip-on or tied for years 3-6)
- School showerproof jacket* or a waterproof outdoor coat (with hood)
- Red, white, navy or black hair band/scrunchie/bow
- School embroidered knitted hat* or other warm hat which is plain in design and suitable/practical for school

Summer Uniform from early May bank holiday

- Plain white polo shirt* (with or without the school logo)
- Tailored grey trousers/shorts (as appropriate) or skirt*
- Red and white check summer dress*/playsuit
- Grey or white socks
- White or navy tights
- Black shoes
- School jumper or cardigan*
- School showerproof jacket* or a waterproof outdoor coat (with hood)
- School embroidered baseball/summer hat * or a sunhat/cap with neck protector which is plain in design and suitable/practical for school
- Red, white, navy or black hair band/scrunchie/bow

- ★ drawstring bag containing spare clothes (left on their peg)
- ★ lunch box (for those who do not have school lunch)
- ★ water bottle
- ★ please label everything!!!

First Day

8.40 - 8.55am : Drop your child off at the gate with their bookbag, lunchbox (if needed, water bottle, waterproof mac and a change of clothes and shoes to stay in school. We will be there to greet them, guide them into class and deal with any first-day nerves.

8.55am - 10am : The children will spend time familiarising themselves with our indoor and outdoor learning environments and staff

10am-10.15am : Snack time

10.30 - 11.45am: More time to explore our learning environment and getting to know each other.

First day continued...

11.45am: Lunchtime

1pm onwards: Singing and “Getting to Know Each Other” games, before more activity time.

2.30pm: Tidy up time and end of day routine

2.55pm: Story time

3.15pm: Home time. We will dismiss the children one by one to you at our Reception gate - please help us to get to know faces faster by coming forward when you see your child next in the line.
